

Applicant's Supporting Documents

It is the responsibility of the JAMP applicant to meet with his/her JAMP Faculty Director prior to starting the application. In addition it is the applicant's responsibility to assist the JAMP Faculty Director in collecting the supporting documents.

The following documents are required to be submitted by the University JAMP Faculty Director. These documents must be received by the JAMP Administrative office no later than **October 15th** for the application to be considered for review.

1. Notice of Intent to Apply and Authorization to Release Records **(One Form)**
2. High School Transcript and Class Rank
3. SAT/ACT Scores
4. FASFA – Student Aid Report (SAR)*:
 - a. 2008-2009 SAR
 - b. 2009-2010 SAR
5. JAMP Applicant Evaluation Forms from:
 - a. JAMP Faculty Director
 - b. University Faculty
6. College Transcripts (Community or any other Colleges Attended)
7. Official University Transcript
