## How to Qualify:

- ☐ Enroll in an institution of higher education no later than the first fall semester following graduation from high school or a home-schooled program.
- ☐ Be enrolled as a full-time student at a participating Texas college or university at the time of application.
- ☐ Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of up to 8000 or be Pell Grant Eligible.
- ☐ Complete a minimum of 27 undergraduate credit hours prior to applying, which must include General Chemistry I & II with associated labs, with C or better.
- ☐ Earn a 3.25 GPA or higher and 3.25 BCPM GPA in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Math courses.
- ☐ Be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident and be a Texas Resident.
