JAMP Scholar Summer Internship Evaluation Form

Intent: To give scholars detailed feedback on summer performance and was developed with the help of the Medical School Coordinators

- > August 31: Recommended evaluator completion
- September: the login information for each JFD to review the evaluation with scholars shared by JAMP Administration

EY22 JAMP Scholars Applying to TMDSAS for medical school

- 96 Scholars Current
- 42 have MCAT passed (44% passing rate): Scholars are eligible for an interview and have a complete application
- > September 9: Last MCAT retest date
- > January 2024: All students will have to be interviewed.
- > February 9, 2024: Match results released.






EY23 Scholars

- ✓ Received books from Kaplan during the summer.
- ✓ Starting weekly bio/chemistry enrichment classes on August 22 until December.
- ☐ December: Scholars will take the KAT2 test to determine scholar strengths and weaknesses.
- ☐ January 2024: Scholars begin MCAT Preparation courses and take MCAT practice tests (includes AAMC and Kaplan full-length tests)
- ☐ September: Gain access to UWorld through September 2024



EY24 Applicants Interested students currently applying.

- > 299 Started Applications
- Note: 581 total started the last cycle.
- > 2 Submitted Applications.
- Note: 266 total applications last cycle.



- Cohort possibility of being under a new MCAT vendor
- Cohort size increased from 100 to 150, funded by the 88th Texas Legislative Session



EY24 Applicant Schedule

- > October 31, 2023: Application Closes
- October 31st: Deadline to provide supporting documents
- December 12, 2023: Applicants selected for interview during the Council Meeting
- > January 2024: Applicant interview conducted virtually

SCHEDULE

February – March 2024: Applicant selection and notification





JAMP Application

> SAT/ACT Scores: Removed for EY24 Applicants

- > Notice of Intent: Council voted for it to be embedded in the application.
 - Beginning EY25, the form will be automatically generated in the application and readily available in the JFD Portal for access.



JAMP Application

Evaluation Forms: Modified Options

- > Option #1: JFD AND University Faculty
- > Option #2: JFD (*preferred*) OR University Faculty AND University Faculty

CHANCE

- > Option #3: JFD (*preferred*) OR University Faculty AND Qualified Evaluator to Speak to Core Competencies*
 - These include for the qualified evaluator: High School Counselor, High School Teacher, Work or Volunteer Supervisor, Extracurricular Program Coordinator, or Mentor
- > Beginning with EY24 Cohort, the options will be available in the application.
